

#28 HODGKINS COVE LANDING:

Washington St. by Marine Lab. Vehicle access, launching ramp by monument. Stairs down to water and beach. High tide only. Ipswich Bay. Parking on street.

#29 LANES COVE LANDING:

Duley and Andrew Streets., Lanesville. Vehicle access, small launch area, parking. Float for temporary tie-ups.

#30 HEAD OF LOBSTER COVE LANDING:

Washington St. to Lane Rd., Annisquam. Small park, grass launch area. High tides only. Annisquam River.

#34 PLUM COVE LANDING:

Washington St. in Bayview, at beach. Parking across street. Launch over sand. Not useable during beach hours. Ipswich Bay.

#38 LONG WHARF LANDING (Stone Pier):

Off Atlantic St. on Jones Creek (Annisquam River). Vehicle access, small parking lot. Launch area with ramp. High tide only.

#46 COUNTY LANDING:

Way off Stacy Blvd., at Pavillion Beach. Next to The Tavern. Small parking area. Launch area over sand. High tide without 4-wheel drive.

#47 STANWOOD POINT LANDING:

Off Stanwood Ave. Unpaved parking area. Launch area on left. High tides only. Little River.

#52 ROCKY NECK LANDING:

Rocky Neck Ave. at city parking lot. Foot access over riprap. High tide only. Smith Cove.

#56 CORLISS LANDING:

End of Apple St. Vehicle access, unpaved parking area. Ramp. High tide only. Annisquam River.

Water Access Over Beaches: During the season, Memorial Day to Labor Day, the following beaches are not usable during the hours from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM for launches of any type. After hours and beyond the season, watercraft may only be launched by portage (with permission from the Harbor Master). Driving on the beaches is not permitted.

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#1 CRIPPLE COVE LANDING:

East Main St. adjacent to Ben Smith Playground.
Small parking lot.

#4 ROBINSON'S LANDING:

East Main St. at Pirate's Lane. No on-site parking.
High tide only, Smith Cove.

#5 FLAT (WONSON) COVE LANDING:

East Main St. at Ledge Lane, Wonson Cove.
Parking at city lot on Rocky Neck Ave. High tide
only. Foot access. (Public park and flats also
across from parking lot.)

#7 TOWN LANDING (St. Peter's Park):

Junction of Washington & Commercial St. Parking
in city lot. Accommodates larger boats. Located in
inner harbor, has gangway.

#10 LOBSTER COVE LANDING:

Washington St. to Leonard Unpaved way and
launch area. Limited parking both sides of foot-
bridge. High tides only. Annisquam

#11 TRENEL COVE LANDING:

South Ferry St. off Washington St. Vehicle access,
limited parking (2 spaces) on side of way. (Way is
access to abutter's driveway, so do not block.)
Small beach. High tides only. Annisquam River.

#13 STUBBY KNOWLES LANDING:

Essex Ave. across from Magnolia Ave. Unpaved
parking area (4 spaces) to the right. Small boats -
carry down. Smelt fishing pier. High tide only.
Little River.

#14 CLAY PIT LANDING:

Concord St. between Thompson and Atlantic. On
Jones Creek. High tide only. Marsh. Not very
usable. No parking.

#16 KENT'S COVE LANDING:

Concord St. across from West Parish School. Way
to landing to be 8' gravel (uncleared now). Follow
way to monument, turn left. High tide only. Little
River. No Parking

#17 FRESHWATER COVE LANDING:

Waterside Lane, off Western Avenue.
Vehicle access, but no real parking. Small, rocky
beach on Western Harbor. High tides only. No
parking.

#18 KETTLE COVE LANDING:

Shore Rd. in Magnolia. Vehicle access, ramp to
sandy beach. Limited parking. Pier and float
nearby are public, as is park across the street.

#21 BROWN'S MILL LANDING:

Washington St. at Hodgkins, beside monument.
Vehicle access and ramp. Parking on
Washington St. High tide only. Mill River.

#23 DUNFUDGIN PUBLIC BOAT RAMP:

Off Centennial Ave. At the end of Emerson
Avenue down on the left. Ramp, Large parking
for truck and trailer parking only. Annisquam
River by the "Cut". Useable all tides. Daily user
fee;
seasonal passes available.

#24 FOLLY COVE LANDING:

Washington St. at Folly Cove, near Rockport line
Foot access down dirt path. Small parking area.
Rocky beach on Ipswich Bay.

#25 GREEN LANDING:

Washington St. at Grant Circle besides shopping
area. Foot access beside monument. Channel
at high tides. Annisquam River

CAUTION !: Most of the landings are useable at high tides only. Be aware of the tide schedules.

NOTE: All floats at public landings are drop off and pick up only.
